

Isaac Stuttgart
President: 1821-1823

Arriving from Amsterdam in 1807, Stuttgart opened a “fancy goods” store in Philadelphia. Though he served as RS secretary from 1817-18 and as president as, he joined Mikveh Israel in 1824, as there was much movement between the two synagogues and many dual memberships as well. During his tenure, the synagogue moved from close to the Betsy Ross house to another building near Christ Church. 1830 was when Stuttgart was buried in the 8th and Spruce cemetery.
