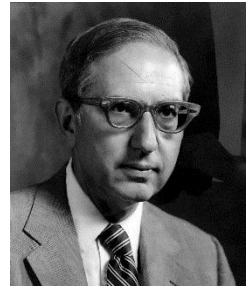


Robert P. Frankel
President: 1973-1976

Born in Philadelphia, Mr. Frankel graduated from Cheltenham High School in 1939, earned a bachelor's degree from the University of North Carolina in 1942, and graduated from the University of Pennsylvania Law School in 1948. He served with the Army Air Corps during World War II, and after the war his military assignment was to work with Boy Scouts on Guam. Mr. Frankel was treasurer of the Jewish Publication Society from 1974 to 1976, its vice president from 1977 to 1979, and again its treasurer from 1980 to 1983. Frankel was a 4th generation board member of Rodeph Shalom.



He was a board member of many prominent institutions, including Eagleville Hospital, Abington Memorial Hospital, the Noble Improvement Association, the Lawyers' Club in Philadelphia, Philmont Country Club, and was a member of the Locust Club for more than 30 years. Mr. Frankel became a partner in Fox, Rothschild, O'Brien & Frankel in 1958.
